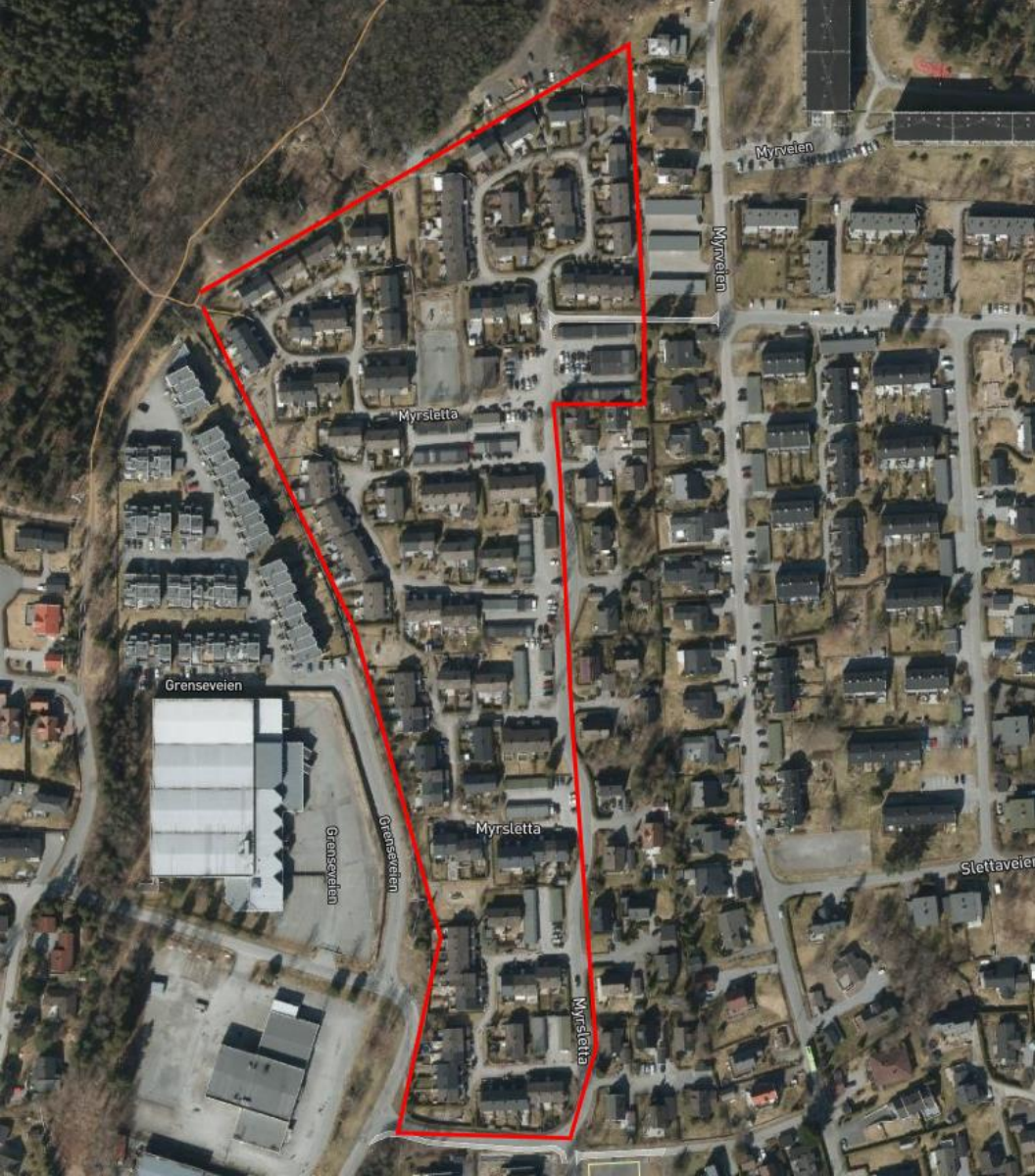

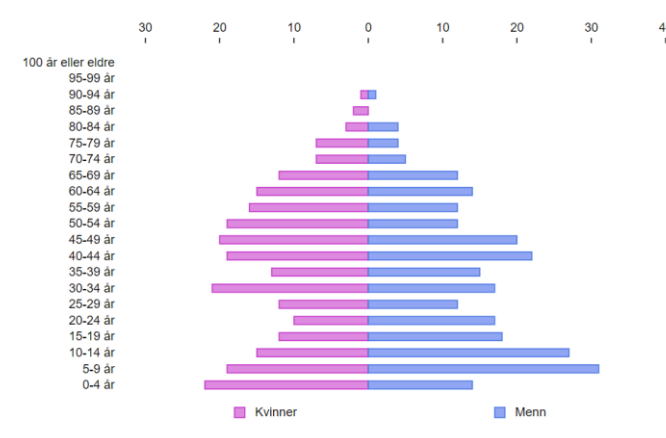
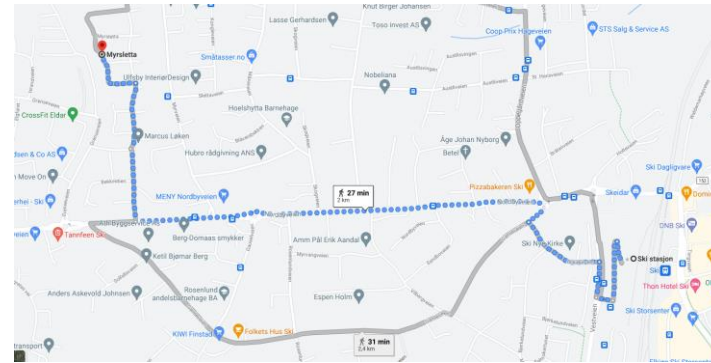


Aerial view Myrsletta



Myrsletta: facts

- 2 km from Ski center, 27 min walk to Ski station
- School district: Hebekk barneskole (primary school), Ski ungdomsskole (junior high school)
- Field A, was regulated in 1981 and building started in 1989
- Consists of town- and semi-detached houses (divided vertically)
- Approximately 500 residents, some families with children, but also some seniors



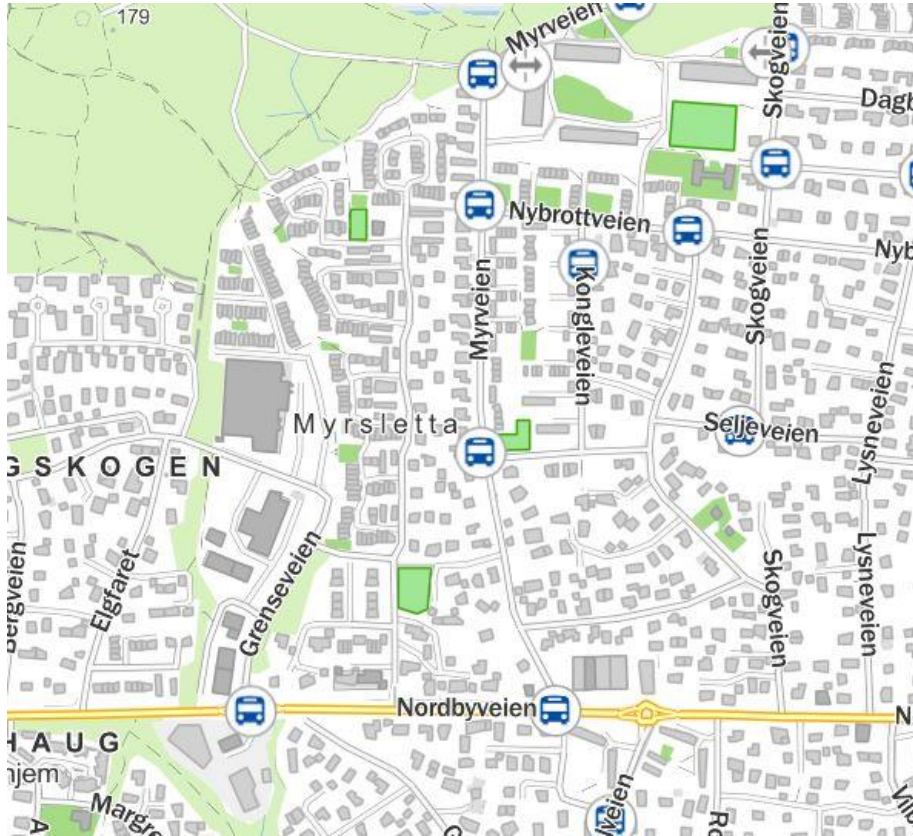

Public transport (bus) stops Myrsletta



- Climate changes and especially the loss of species is a concern
- The risk of loss of species and future land use is dominant
- Expected to grow quick due to improved connection via commuter trains to Oslo
- This is a challenge especially with regards to land use and mobility.

Main findings of workshop and interviews

- **Mobility: a very car-dependent neighbourhood, 2 and up to 5 cars in one household**
- **A will to use more collective transport and non-motorised means, bikes and e-bikes, some e-scooters amongst the youth**
- **Safety when biking and walking is a concern, especially when getting kids to school**
- **Improved marking of bike paths (suggested)**
- **New garages are being discussed – now more of a plan with building permit in process and even a proposal of solar collectors on garages**
- **E-cars a possibility, chargers are to be implemented in new garages**

Main findings of workshop and interviews

- Car sharing is interesting: replacing car #2 probably realistic
- Better bus connection (especially frequency and time table of buses)
- The possibility to commute by train and public transport/non-motorised alternatives
- Ambition is growing continually with the project
- To school by foot – campaign joined by local school
- Mobility week (Nordre Follo Municipality) 16-22 sept



Main findings of questionnaire (confirming the workshop and interview results)

- 28 answers after targeted measures: local youth knocking doors
- Too long questionnaire
- Results show need for improvement of public transport and building stock in need or improvement
- 80% of respondents with higher education levels
- No climate-sceptics
- Relatively close-knit society



Mobility Event September 22 (Great engagement and results)

- Bike repairs (free)
- Results of Survey and Workshops presented (NTNU)
- Drawing competition: Children showed great imagination and visioning
- Car-sharing solution represented
- local media reported

New emanated ambition:

- Ambition to cut down personal cars with 50%
- Garages aimed to have solar collectors to charge cars
- Great interest in replacing car #2 with electric car-sharing option





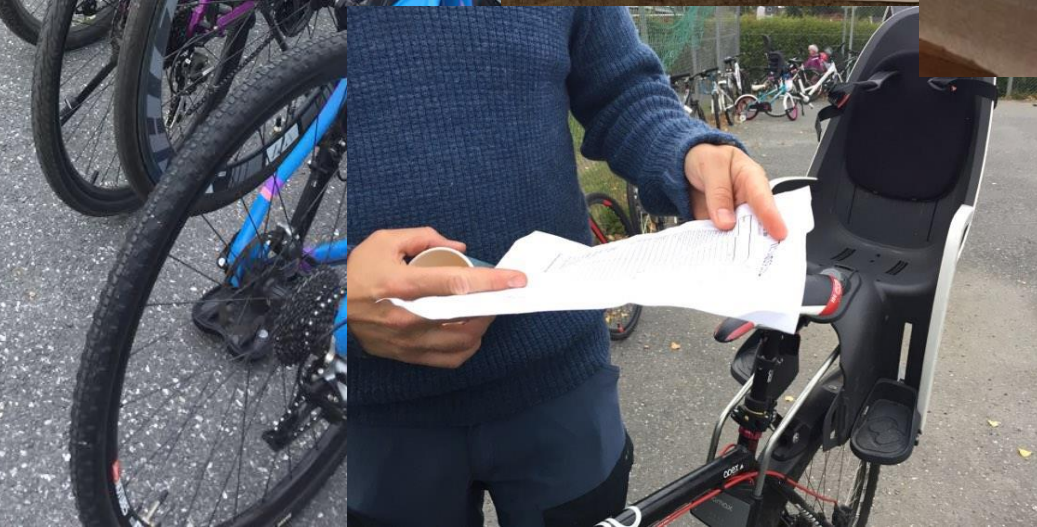
